ORDINANCE NO. 2015- 1

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BORROWING OF FUNDS IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,500,000 TO BE USED TO FINANCE THE ACQUISITION AND INSTALLATION OF A PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOPEWELL, VIRGINIA, THAT:**

1. It is determined to be necessary and expedient for the City of Hopewell, Virginia (the "City"), to finance the acquisition and installation of a public safety communications system (the "Project"), and to borrow money (the "Borrowing") for such purposes.
2. Pursuant to the Constitution and statutes of the Commonwealth of Virginia, including the Public Finance Act of 1991, it is authorized to be borrowed a maximum principal amount not to exceed \$2,500,000 to finance the Project and pay the costs of such Borrowing.
3. The Borrowing shall bear such date or dates, mature at such time or times not exceeding 40 years from their dates, bear interest at such rate or rates, be in such denominations and form, be executed in such manner and be secured or sold at such time or times and in such manner as the Council may hereafter provide by appropriate resolution or resolutions.
4. The Borrowing shall be a general obligation of the City for the payment of principal and premium, if any, and interest on which its full faith and credit shall be irrevocably pledged.
5. The City Clerk, in collaboration with the City Attorney, is authorized and directed to see to the immediate filing of a certified copy of this ordinance in the Circuit Court of the City of Hopewell, Virginia.
6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
