## CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP FEES

Minimum of 10

Fee: \$180.00. Additional fee of \$40 can be added for each racquetball membership.

## SPECIAL AREA FEES

### Racquetball/Handball Fees:

Non-Racquetball Membership must pay the following to use courts:

Residents: \$3 each player

Non-Residents: \$4 each player

### Annual Racquetball Membership:

(Unlimited use of courts)

Residents: \$220

Non-Residents: \$295

Courts may be reserved one day in advance.

Reservations are on a first-call basis.

### Skateboard Park:

#### No Fees

Open to the public. Helmets are required.

Knee pads and elbow pads are recommended.

Hours of Operation: Monday-Friday- 9 to dusk.

Saturday 9-5 – Sunday 9 to dusk.

## RULES FOR COMMUNITY CENTER MEMBERSHIP

1. During scheduled hours, the holder of a valid membership card is entitled to use of the gym, pool, sauna, exercise room, tennis courts and locker rooms.
2. Admission into the Community Center requires presentation of a valid membership card. Failure to produce a valid card will prevent entrance into the Center.
3. Visitors entering the Center must purchase a visitor pass or a membership card.
4. Annual card holders who move more than 50 miles from the city of Hopewell during the first six months of membership may be reimbursed for up to 50% of fees paid.
5. The [Department of Recreation & Parks](#) reserves the right to change fees and hours as necessary. All changes will be posted at the Center.

## FREE TIME FOR HOPEWELL STUDENTS

Hopewell students holding at least a Daily Membership Card may use the Center at no charge on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, from 3 to 5 p.m. Saturday Free Time is from 9 a.m. to noon.

### Meeting Room:

Residents without kitchen: \$26.00 for 3 hours plus \$20.00 refundable security deposit is required.

Residents with kitchen: \$48.00 for 3 hours plus \$20.00 refundable security deposit is required. Non-Resident without kitchen: \$47.00 for 3 hours plus \$20.00 refundable security deposit is required.

Non-Resident with kitchen: \$68.00 for 3 hours plus \$20.00 refundable security deposit is required.

### PRO SHOP

Various small items used in swimming, exercise, skating, and racquetball may be purchased at the front desk.

### SCHEDULES

#### Swimming Pool, Exercise Room, Gym, Sauna

The above listed areas will be open for general use when scheduled classes and activities are not being held. Class times are 9:00a.m.-11:00a.m. and 5:00p.m.-8:00p.m. Mon-Fri. If there are no classes scheduled during these hours, the pool and gym will be open for public use. The Center is open for public use all weekend. Exceptions will be posted as needed. Saunas are available during regular operating hours. A detailed schedule for each section of the Center will be posted at the front reception area. As stated in the membership rules.
