



City of Hopewell FALL CLEAN-UP



Make your City Beautiful for the fall. Keep Hopewell Beautiful has scheduled Fall Citywide Clean-up from Saturday, October 19, 2013 to Saturday, October 26, 2013. Hours of operation during “Fall Clean-Up” at the Citizen Convenience Center are 12:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday, and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Citizens are encouraged to participate in this effort by cleaning up around their homes and along their streets. During this week, Hopewell residents may dispose of trash (these are not the items normally placed in a toter on a weekly basis) at no charge at the Citizen Convenience Center located behind Fire Station #1 at 200 South Hopewell Street (near the Department of Public Works). **There will be the usual \$10.25 fee for the removal of Freon to dispose of appliances.** The following items will not be accepted: concrete, masonry, garbage, paint of any kind, batteries, automobile motors, and hazardous waste materials. Tires are limited to four (4) per person, and **they must be separated from the rim.** Firestone Tire located in the Cavalier Square Shopping Center will accept tires and batteries during Fall Clean-Up Week. These tires must also be separated from the rim. Help make your neighborhood and City beautiful. “Fall Clean-Up” activities apply to Hopewell residents only.
