
- Attended Regional LEPC meeting in Richmond

## **Steps so far (continued)**


- Applied for \$10,000.00 of the 2008 HMEPG (Hazardous Materials Emergency Planning Grant) to have a contractor complete the project.

## Why New SIP brochure?


- Old brochure outdated
