The City of Hopewell Updates Its Security Policy

Hopewell, Va. - Recent world events have prompted the City of Hopewell to review its internal security policies centered around employee safety. As a result of the review, the new hours of operation for the city hall municipal building are 8am to 4:30pm.

The City of Hopewell has also updated its visitation procedures. All visitors will enter City Hall through the Planning and Development office located at the rear of the building by the parking lot. Visitors will be greeted by the receptionist who will check them in.

Citizens will continue to have access to the building, but may continue leaving payments for the Treasurer's office in the brown mailbox located in the parking lot. As it pertains to the Commissioner of Revenue's office, citizens may continue to leave relevant forms and documents in the drop box located at the side of the building.

We join other municipalities in the Commonwealth with updating our security measures to ensure a safer working environment for our employees. Our goal is to provide structure with how we continue to serve our citizens of Hopewell.
